

Code of Conduct

As an organization, Cornerstone Christian Academy is committed to honor God and His Word above all. With a mission for EVERY subject to be taught with THE TRUTH of the Bible faithfully and relentlessly INTEGRATED, with LOVE and SOUND DOCTRINE, we pray that the way we operate, and every bit of knowledge learned at Cornerstone Christian Academy would point EVERY person (students, instructors alike) into greater WONDER and LOVE of our Creator, and conviction of the heart to freely FOLLOW and SERVE Jesus, as Savior and Lord, in freedom and hope of the Gospel for His Glory!

In line with this, Cornerstone Christian Academy is <u>committed to creating an environment that helps</u> its mission to thrive!

Key Premises:

- 1. Treatment of other people (fellow students, instructors and staff) must always be respectful.
- 2. The facility and all property will not be abused.
- 3. Each student is responsible for attending class (as Cornerstone is an "open" campus).
- 4. Each student is responsible for his/her own personal possessions.
- 5. Each student is accountable for his/her own actions.
- 6. Each student must use the restroom associated with their biological sex.
- 7. Each student's dress and actions should encourage others to Godliness.
- 8. First and foremost, base everything in love of God and others:

Matthew 22:37-40

"And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

Romans 12:10

"Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor."

Except where noted, the consequences for each category will fall under the General Infractions Procedure.

General Expectations

Church Property

We are grateful for Heartland Evangelical Free Church, whose facility we are using. Staff, students and families agree not to engage in any activities or promote any teachings that would bring scandal to God and His Word, Cornerstone Christian Academy and/or Heartland Evangelical Free Church as our host. Students and parents hold responsibility for the students' attendance on class days.

Classroom Expectations

Each instructor has the responsibility and authority to set behavioral expectations in order to maintain an educational setting that provides for effective learning without inappropriate disruption. In these individual settings, each student is to comply with each instructor's requirements with the understanding that there will be variances between classes. Students are expected to attend class. If absent, students/parents are asked to communicate with the instructor. Students and parents hold responsibility for attendance on class days.

Verbal Expectations

- 1. Bathroom humor and crude language is not permitted.
- 2. Sexually, ethnically orientated jokes, comments or name-calling is prohibited.
- 3. Inappropriate gestures will not be tolerated.
- 4. Calling other people names other than their legal name or personally stated nickname is prohibited. ANYTHING communicated verbally or nonverbally that is deemed inappropriate will be disciplined. **Ephesians 5:4** "and there must be NO filthiness and silly talk, or coarse jesting, which are not fitting."

Lunch Time

- 1. Good Stewardship: Students will clean up messes, throw away trash/containers inappropriate receptacles, wash/load dirty dishes used and accept responsibility for their own personal possessions (bags, bottles, utensils, etc.)
- 2. Tables should be wiped clean of any crumbs or liquid.
- 3. Food allergies present at Cornerstone. Please be conscientious of others around you.
- 4. Students are free to eat lunch in the building or off campus at another establishment with parents' permission.

Arrivals

- 1. Arrive no earlier than 10 mins. prior to the first class session of the day unless special permission has been given.
- 2. Go immediately to their class and wait quietly for class to begin.

Departures

- 1. Final pickup time is 3:45 pm on Mondays (after classes end).
- 2. Anyone still remaining on-site after this time can cause after-hours conflict of schedule for the administration, so *thank you for your promptness!*

Dress Code

Upper Body:

- 1. No spaghetti strap tank tops or strapless shirts
- 2. Tops and bottoms must overlap so midriff skin is not exposed, even when sitting or raising arms.
- 3. Girls must wear bras; no straps showing.
- 4. Necklines should not be revealing.
- 5. Dress must be appropriate to the biological sex of the student.

Lower Body:

- 1. All lower body apparel must be no higher than mid-thigh.
- 2. No underwear showing. This includes but is not limited to boxers and bras.
- 3. No rips or tears in clothing exposing underwear.
- 4. Dress must be appropriate to the biological sex of the student.

Provision for Dress Code Infractions

- 1. Students will be given and required to wear an XL t-shirt by the on-site administrator for upper body infraction.
- 2. Students will be required to contact parent to bring appropriate lower body dress. This will make it possible for students to still attend class.
- 3. Student will not attend class and must exit premise is choses not to comply to the above

Bodily Contact

CORNERSTONE'S goal is to keep all students free from physical harassment of any kind.

Therefore:

No inappropriate physical display of affection

No inappropriate, sexual touch

No rough housing, wrestling, lifting, punching, kicking, bumping, tickling, etc.

Physical Surroundings

Students will respect the physical surroundings of the CORNERSTONE building and landscape (tables, chairs, walls, carpet, grass, parking lot, etc.)

Parking Lots

- 1. No sitting in cars in the parking lot without adult supervision.
- 2. Be watchful of pedestrians when in parking lot Safety First!

Sports Equipment

Skateboards are not allowed inside the building or on the property.

Pets

No pets allowed, generally.

Beverages

Water and clear liquids only should be in the building where there is carpet.

Prohibited Substances and Weapons

No warning will be given in this category Tobacco, drugs, alcohol, weapons, and fireworks are not allowed in the building or parking areas.

Weapon list includes but is not limited to jackknives, box-cutters, blades of any length, and any weapon that could or simulates the firing of a projectile including guns of any type.

Anyone discovered with possession of any of these items during operating hours is subject to possible expulsion from CORNERSTONE for the semester WITHOUT REFUND.

"Open" Campus Explanation

Cornerstone Christian Academy is an open campus similar to a college experience with students arriving and departing for different classes during the day. Therefore, students and parents hold responsibility for attendance and whereabouts on class days.

Visitors

For the safety of those within our facility space:

- 1. Unregistered friends or relatives are not welcome to attend with your student unless prior arrangements have been made with Cornerstone Staff.
- 2. Other unrecognized people in our space at Cornerstone will be asked to leave immediately and reported to the police if unwilling to depart.
- 3. Parents must check in with the on-site administrator for the purpose of visiting a class in session.

Inside the Building

- 1. Students in the building must be within the designated space.
- 2. If a student is discovered by ANY responsible adult to be beyond the designated areas, the students will be brought to the on-site supervisor, and is expected to come willingly.
- 3. Cornerstone staff and instructors do not have the authority to give students permission to leave the campus and neither will we keep track of whether or not your child is permitted by you to leave the campus and/or ride with another student. Parents are responsible for this.

Outside the Building

- 1. There are student drivers arriving and departing from the Cornerstone open campus
- 2. Cornerstone staff and instructors do not have the authority to give students permission to leave the campus and neither will we keep track of whether or not your child is permitted by you to leave the campus and/or ride with another student. Parents are responsible for this.

PARENTS WHO ARE CONCERNED ABOUT THEIR STUDENT'S WHEREABOUTS, SAFETY AND BEHAVIOR IN AN "OPEN" CAMPUS ARE WELCOME TO STAY AND BE PRESENT DURING OPERATING HOURS.

Student Phone & Electronic Device Policy

(Cell Phones/Technology/Laptops/Etc)

In effort to maximize the learning environment, and foster face-to-face relationships, Cornerstone Christian Academy has prayerfully adopted the following policy for phones, internet-connected and other devices during academic hours...

Non-internet-connected Devices:

• Students are allowed to use their non-internet-connected devices (headphones, earbuds, MP3 players, gaming devices and any other electronic devices such as these) on campus before school, lunch, and study hours respectfully. Students are not allowed to listen to music on their personal devices, game, use social media, etc while in class session.

Cell Phones & Internet-Connected Devices:

• During school hours and class time, all student cell phones and internet-connect electronic devices must be turned off, out of sight and kept silent unless given express permission by CCA staff. Cell phones/electronic devices and ring tones should not be heard in hallways, classrooms, etc.

- Students are generally not allowed to use social media, etc while in class. Research does not support this practice as a strategy for student success, and Cornerstone Christian Academy strives to maximize students' learning potential and atmosphere for excellence. If, however, a student is given express permission from his/her teacher to use a cell phone, in class, for an educational-purpose only, that is allowable.
- In general, students (along with staff and instructors) are to refrain from using content on electronic devices that is not God-honoring and is not conducive for all ages at Cornerstone Christian Academy.
- Cornerstone Christian Academy recognizes that though our electronic devices can be used as tools to accomplish good, there are also natural tendencies toward a phone-addicted life, and following lures and temptations within games, streaming movies, social media, etc that promote sexual immorality, sorcery, witchcraft or dark themes that are not in alignment with (and distract from) Cornerstone Christian Academy's goals to teach and train in Truth.
- Taking pictures, video, or sound recordings of anyone, without their permission, is strictly prohibited. Posting pictures, video, or sound recordings of others on any social media platform/sending via text or email, without their permission, may result in expulsion and/or revocation of membership. This includes, but is not limited to, Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok, Pinterest, Twitter, YouTube...

If a student is using a cell phone or electronic device, with the exception of educational purposes, for any other reason during the restricted times, the following procedures will be implemented:

- 1. Cell Phone/Electronic device abuse or distraction will result in the device being confiscated from the student and returned to the student at the end of the day.
- 2. If there is persistent abuse of this policy or distraction, a parent/student conference will take place with the administration to determine next steps.

CORNERSTONE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST, STOLEN OR BROKEN CELL PHONES, AND WILL NOT PAY FOR PHONES THAT ARE LOST, STOLEN OR MISPLACED.

Discipline

Ephesians 5:10 "Trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord." NASB

The word trying is important here. God knows and CORNERSTONE knows that no one is perfect. Cornerstone students are not characterized by disobedience. The basis for discipline at Cornerstone is that we are all working towards behavior that honors God, other people and their possessions.

There will be NO TOLERANCE for behavior, clothing, or possession that does not contribute to the seven premises on which this Code of Conduct is based.

Cornerstone retains the right to discipline a person for involvement in a situation or possession of an item that has not been previously mentioned.

The discipline procedure used will depend on the perceived severity of the offense. While our goal and intention is to use the disciplinary policy for all situations, we recognize that a situation may arise that requires immediate expulsion of a student.

In that event, Cornerstone reserves the right to expel a student immediately or on short notice with or without explanation.

General Discipline Procedure

1st Offense

Remind the student of the expectation.

Separate from the other students immediately, if deemed necessary.

2nd Offense

Step 1: Send the student to the on-site administrator for the remainder of the period.

Step 2: The staff who responded to the offense will notify the parent of the inappropriate behavior at the end of the day by e-mail or by phone.

Step 3: Parent/s need to respond by email or phone to the instructor or on-site administrator acknowledging the concern and having discussed appropriate behavior with their student. Student(s) will make restitution or apologies, if requested.

Step 4: Should this set of steps need to be followed two times with the same student, either by the same or different person, within fall and/or spring semesters, Cornerstone will hold a conference with the parent/s and student/s to determine if the student/s will be allowed to continue attending Cornerstone.

Major Infraction Procedure

(Bodily Contact, Inappropriate Touch, Dress Code, Music, Parking Lot, Pets, Physical Surrounding, and Verbal)

1st Offense: The student and parents will be notified immediately.

2nd Offense: The student will leave the premises for the remainder of the day.

Student drivers will exit by themselves with parent notification.

Non-Student drivers will exit by parent pick up with parent notification.

3rd Offense: The student will be expelled from all classes for the semester WITHOUT REFUND.

Cornerstone Christian Academy reserves the right to adjust disciplinary measures as a situation requires.
